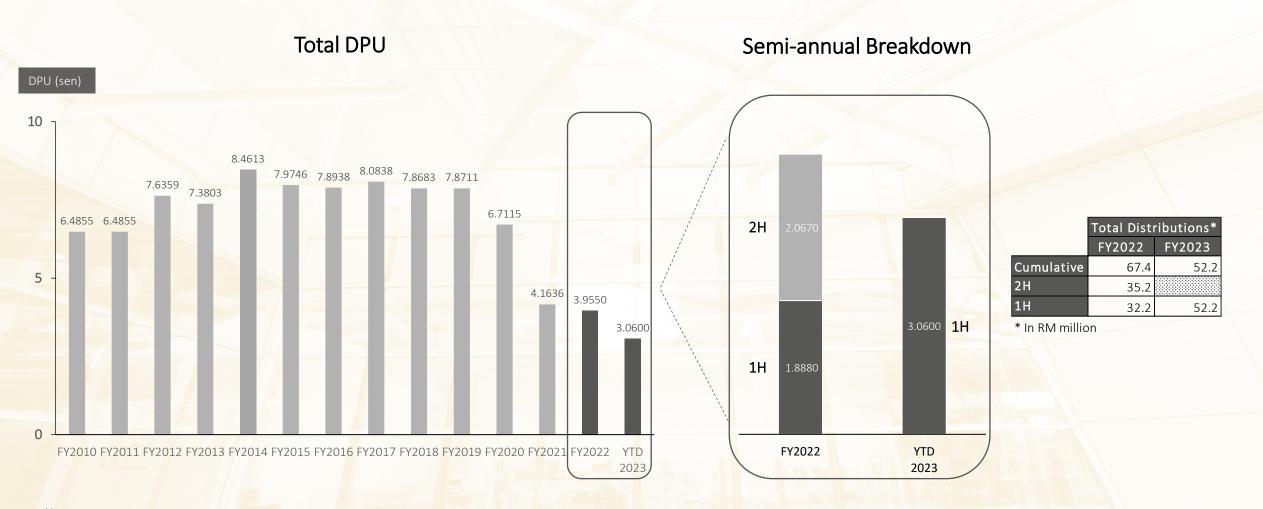

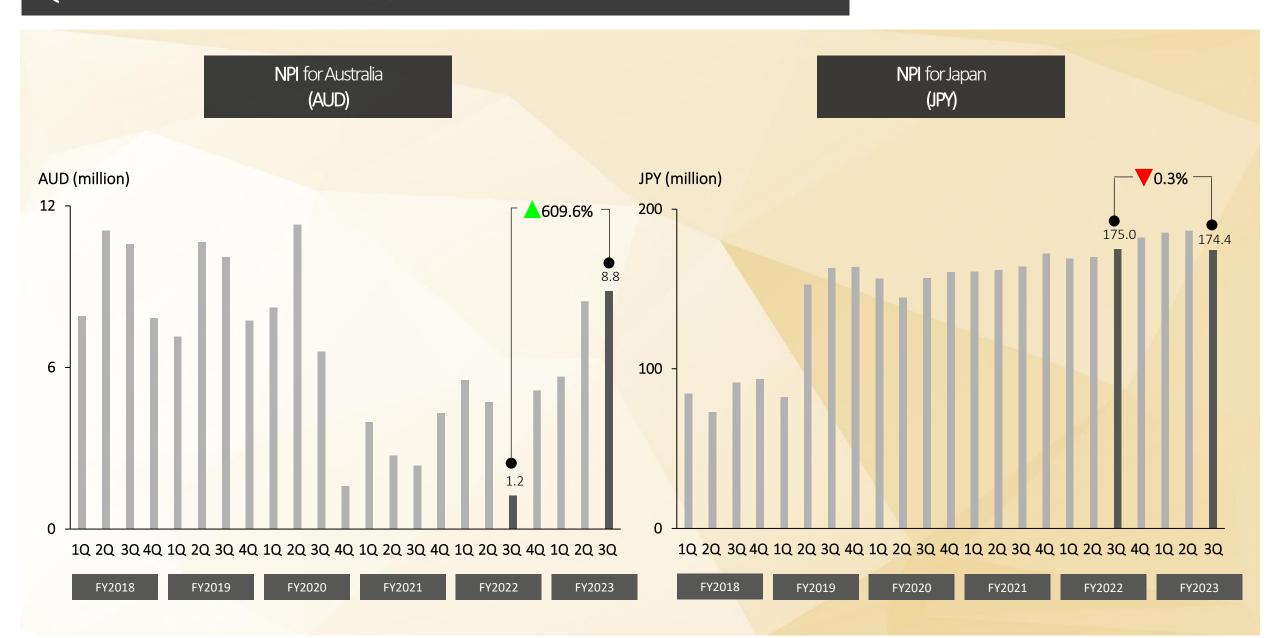

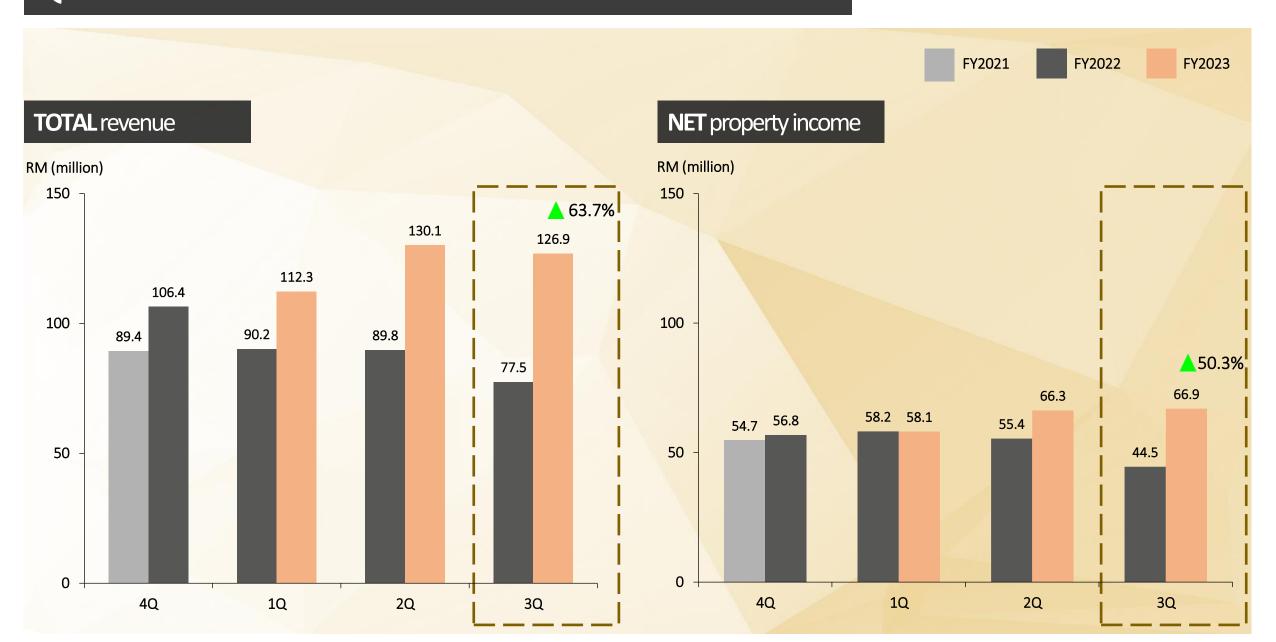

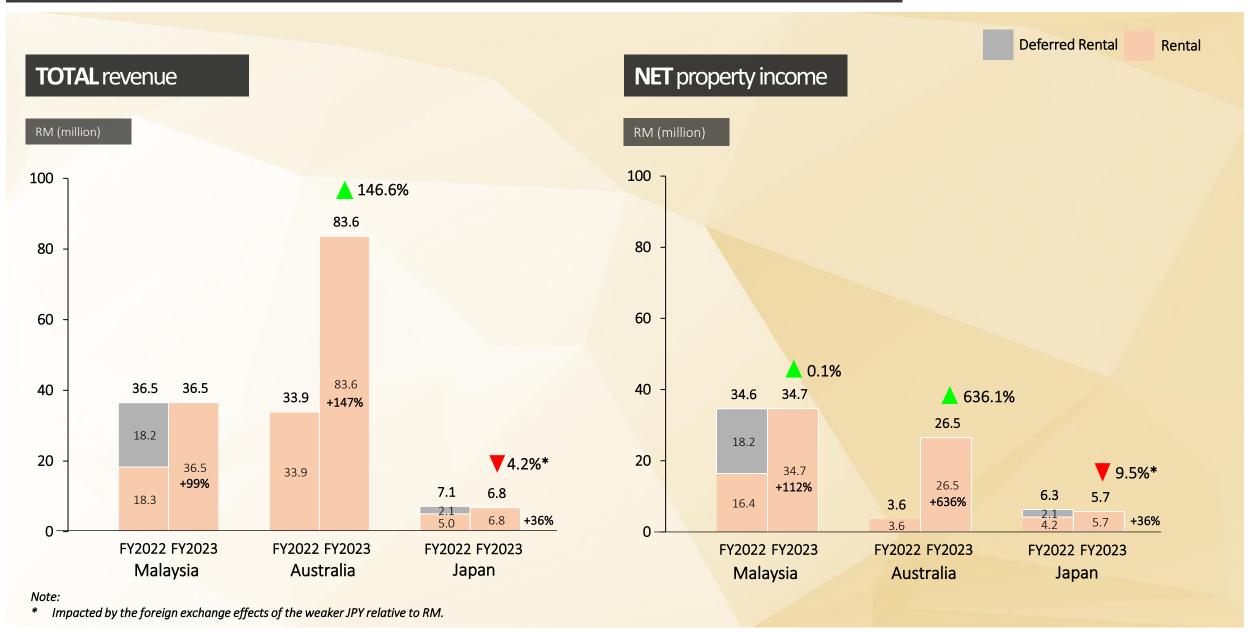
QUARTERLY NPI FOR **AUSTRALIA AND JAPAN**



QUARTERLY FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE



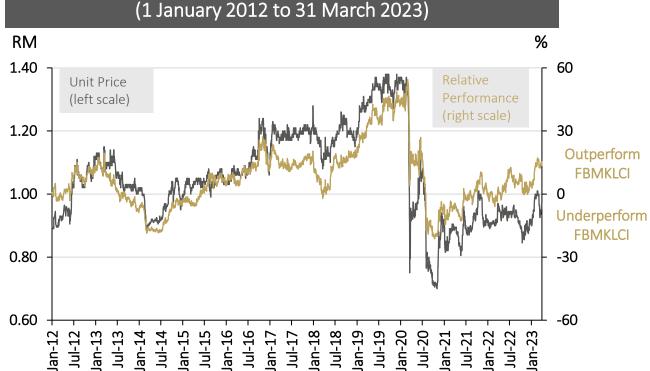
THIRD QUARTER FINANCIAL PERFORMANCES BY COUNTRY



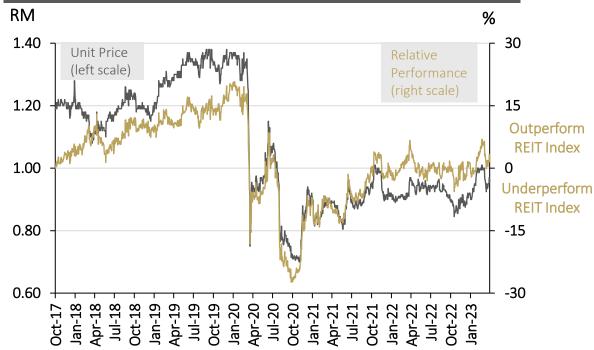

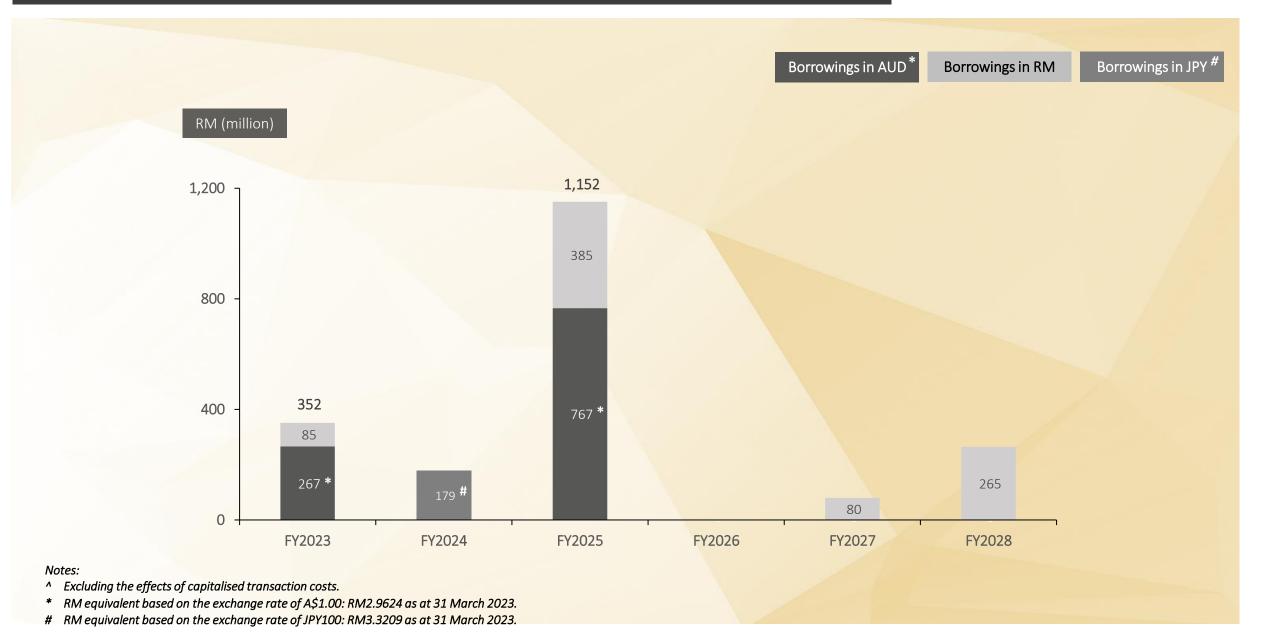

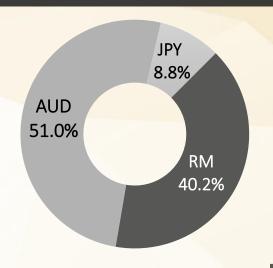
DEBT^ MATURITY PROFILE

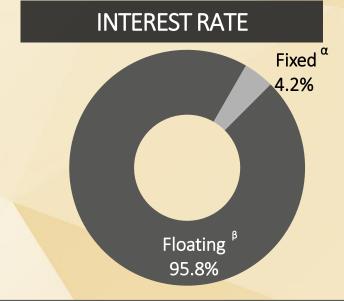


DEBT^ PROFILE AS AT **31 MARCH 2023**

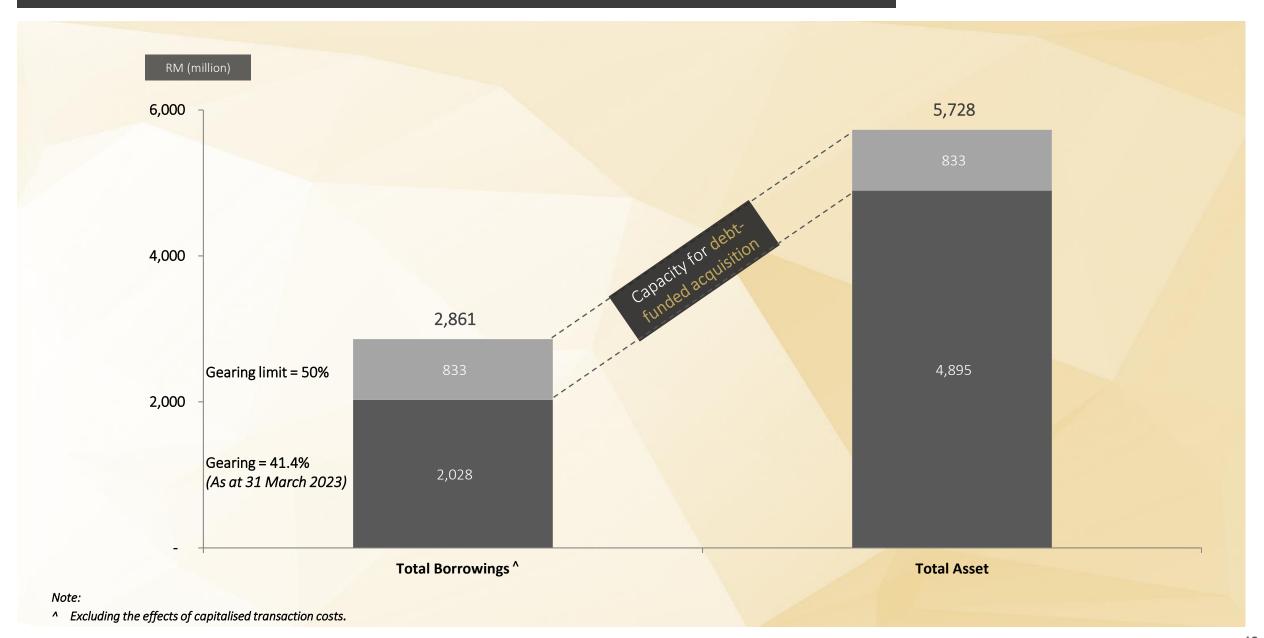

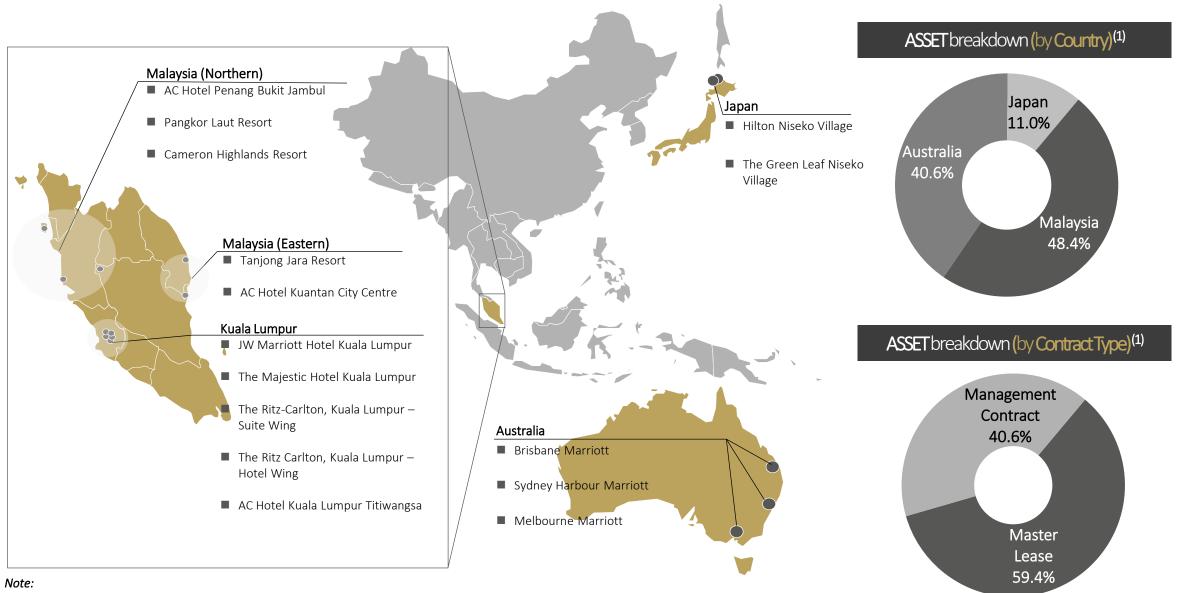

DEBT HEADROOM OF ~RM833 million FOR ACQUISITIONS





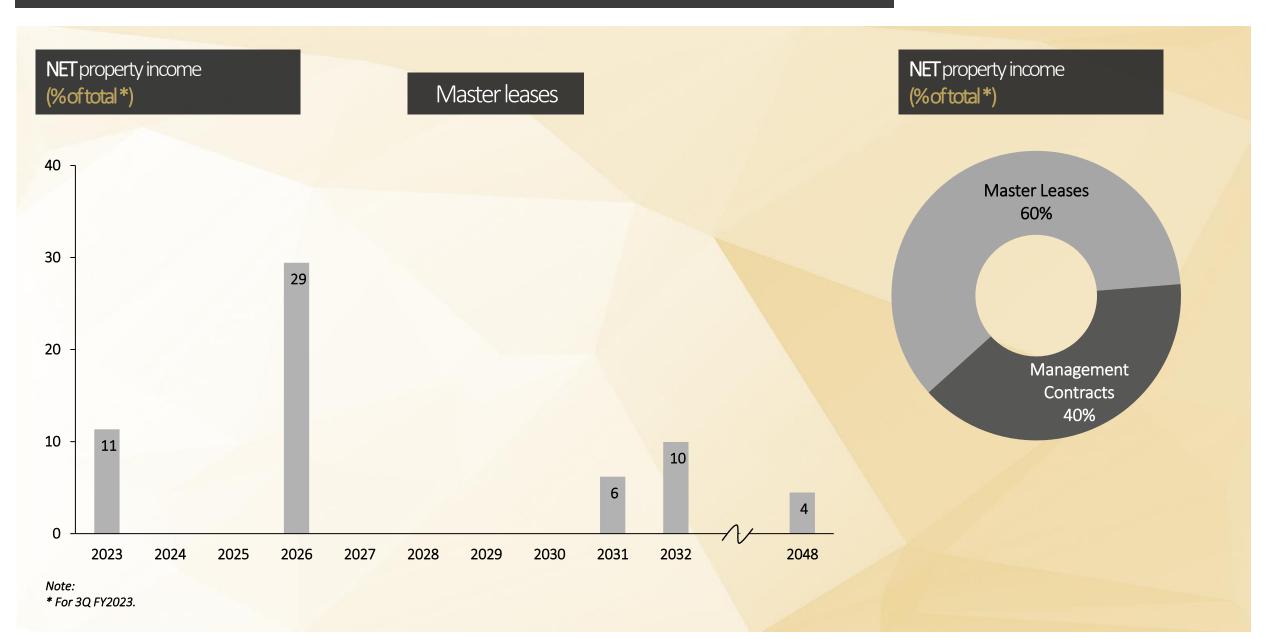

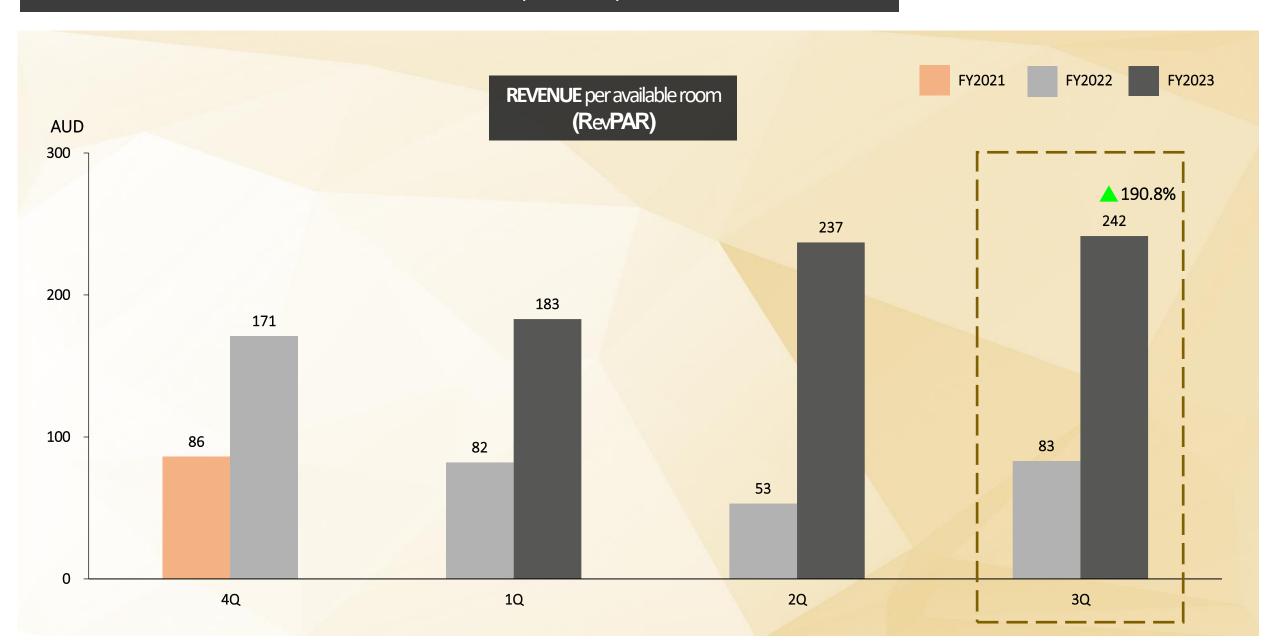

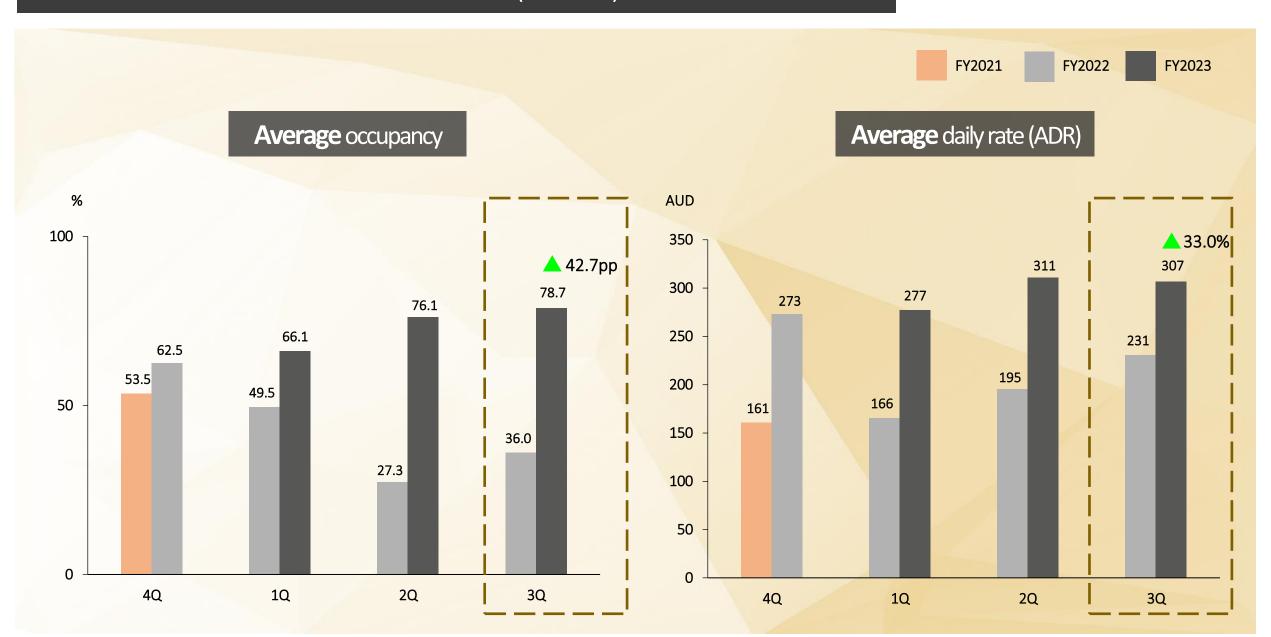
